Gearing up for Contract Negotiations

Your newly elected leadership is ready to get out and learn what our members are looking for as we start the contract campaign. Local 1842, along with 2508 (clerical), will joint negotiate since our current contracts end December 31st. 2020. The last raise of our current contract came on January 4th of 2020 and was a 2.75% COLA (Cost of Living Assessment). While raises in the form of steps and COLA's are important, there are other

working conditions that matter to us as well. We have heard our members come forward with issues of safety in the workplace. Lack of safety comes in many forms— from uniforms, staff to participant ratios, short staffing is rampant across City departments. Help us, help you. Local 1842 has spent over 2 years fighting a 30+ year problem of our employer keeping the "Temp 99" workers from being covered under our collective bargaining agreement. We moved over 100 staff into certified titles, but still have more work to be done to stop this exploitative hiring practice.
