- President's Report
  - Insurance Labor Management Committee (ILMC)
    - Has not met yet this year
    - Panning for training with Bureau of Mediation Services (BMS) next week on 2/1/21
  - Labor Management Committee (LMC)
    - Joint BMS training with HR held on 1/21/21
    - Can appoint up to 7 AFSCME members
    - Meetings every other month
    - Will be reviewing bylaws and file sharing process
  - Elections
    - Will be held online this year due to COVID-19
    - Nominations in March, uncontested races would automatically elected, would send out notice of elections by February 22 (need to send to Council 5 by 2/12)

- o Elections online voting for contested elections
  - Discussed during President's Report
- MOU Post-Retirement Health Care Savings Plan
  - Allows employees with PTO in excess of 500 hours, after December 1, any PTO accrued would be accrued at dollar-equivalent into HCSP instead of losing it
  - HCSP can be used after retirement for insurance premiums, out of pocket medical costs, dental, etc.
  - Works in conjunction with Health Savings Accounts (HSAs)
  - Not tied to any medical insurance plan—savings for retirement only
- o 2021 Holidays
  - Christmas Eve (Friday) and Christmas (Saturday)
  - County wants to be open on 12/23 and 12/27, suggested a floating holiday that gets added the week of Christmas and can be carried over into 2022/used like PTO
    - Concerns about this process, would make more sense to have a day off on Thursday 12/23 or Monday 12/27
    - Gather feedback from members on options
    - Will discuss on 2/9 GM meeting
