State Contract Vote Happening NOW

State contract voting for Units 2-7 began Monday and goes through Friday, August 9. Voting sites are conveniently located across the state.

The contract proposal includes wage increases, insurance improvements, and other wins that will benefit state employees for years to come. The tentative agreement has been unanimously recommended for approval by the state executive branch negotiating team.

Only active union members are allowed to participate in contract votes. AFSCME leaders will be available at voting sites to help non-members join on the spot. You can also call our Member Action Center (1-800- 652-9791) to become a member over the phone.

Locals Reach Tentative Agreements

Local 638 (Sodexo) reached a TA for a three-year contract that includes a 2 percent raise in 2019, 2.5 percent in 2020 and 2.75 percent in 2021, plus an increase of \$0.75 - \$1.50 in starting wages for all classifications. The workers also won 15 minutes of company time for New Member Orientation for new hires and an added Lead Employee Premium of \$1 into the contract.

State Contract Unit 25 (Radio Dispatch Operators), who are part of State Local 3142, have reached a tentative agreement that includes raises of 2.25 percent this year and 2.5 percent in 2020, as well as the same insurance package agreed to by the master state negotiating team for Units 2-7. The contract also includes language improvements on mandatory overtime, vacation reduction discipline and overtime eligibility. The Unit 25 negotiating team unanimously recommends ratification of the new agreement.

Local 1337 (Minnesota Senior Living) reached a TA that includes wage increases of 2.5 percent in the first year and a wage reopener in the second year, vacation and sick time for part time staff, vacation accruals starting from hire date, a new employer retirement match consistent with non-union employees, and language that ensures raises for all staff in the AFSCME bargaining unit if non-union staff get a raise.
