AFSCME Council 5 members—we did it! Because of **YOUR** union and the solidarity of thousands of members across the state in the executive and judicial branch, we successfully fought back the employer's massive health insurance attacks! We reached an incredible Tentative Agreement on insurance at 6:10 AM on Friday, June 27th.

The State came to the table with proposals that would have added THOUSANDS of dollars in ADDITIONAL costs every single year. We're talking skyrocketing deductibles, inflated copays, outrageous max-out-of-pocket limits, prescription drug costs, and more. But none of this is happening—because we fought back and we won! That is the power of being in a union!

To be clear... Thanks to the strength of our bargaining team and the collective power of our union members, those harmful plan design changes are OFF THE TABLE. That means you keep the coverage you've earned—without being gouged at every turn.

What We Protected:

We preserved the structure of your current health plan—no new deductibles, no jacked-up copays, no drastic increases in your maximum out-of-pocket. That's real money saved and a huge victory for all public employees.

Final premium rates are not yet confirmed, and we will continue to monitor and update you when we have more certainty. But this deal saves you **THOUSANDS** of dollars every year and **WE FOUGHT OFF** premium design shifts - a major win!
